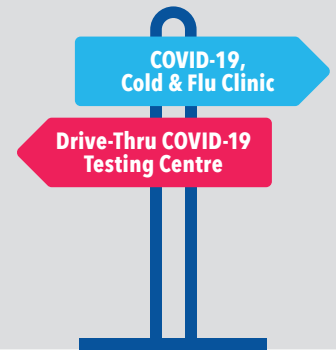


Know where to go when you think you have **THE FLU, A COLD, OR COVID-19**

COVID-19, cold and flu symptoms are very similar and testing is the best way to diagnose which of these illnesses a person may have. William Osler Health System provides convenient, safe options for COVID-19 testing, as well as assessment and care for people who have flu-like symptoms.



Visit a Drive-Thru COVID-19 Testing Centre if you:

Have no symptoms or mild flu-like symptoms such as:

- Runny nose
- Mild cough
- Sore throat

Do not need to see a doctor

Feel you need to be tested for COVID-19

Anyone over the age of 2 years can be tested

No referral or appointment needed

Visit Osler's COVID-19, Cold and Flu Clinic if you:

Have moderate symptoms such as:

- **Fever** (temperature of 37.8°C or above) that's not caused from a known infection or illness
- **Any worsening:**
 - Cough, shortness of breath
 - Sore throat or hoarse voice
 - Runny nose or sneezing, nasal congestion
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Pink eye/redness of eye(s)
 - Nausea and vomiting, or diarrhea, or abdominal pain
 - Flu-like illness

Need to see a doctor

Anyone over the age of 6 months can be tested
