Go to an Emergency Department for **medical emergencies** and serious injuries or conditions:



Chest pain or abdominal pain



Shortness of breath



Pregnancy-related emergencies



Internal bleeding



Numbness or weakness in arms or hands



Major trauma



Mental health issues



Fever in infants three months old and **younger**



Seizures or stroke symptoms

Go to the Urgent Care Centre for **non-life threatening** illnesses or injuries:

Sprains, strains or broken bones



Allergic reactions or skin rashes



Asthma attacks



Minor burns



Cuts that might need stitches



Earaches or eye injuries



Fevers (in infants **older** than three months), coughs and colds



Infections



Nose and throat complaints



If you are uncertain, go to your nearest emergency department.
